1. **English:** IB English B meets the American Literature requirement.
2. **Spanish:** At least one and preferably two Spanish for Native Speakers courses are required.
3. **Social Studies:** Students will take IB Economics as juniors/seniors, so they should take World History and U.S. History in 9th and 10th grade. It would be helpful to take Government as well.
4. **Science:** Students need Biology and a Physical Science (Physical Science, Physics, or Chemistry).
5. **Math:** Algebra I, Algebra II, and Geometry are required, but if a student cannot take Geometry in 10th grade, he/she can take is an elective class in 11th grade.
6. **IB Elective:** Please note the requirements for IB electives.
7. Your other elective choices may include a career pathway, P.E., fine arts, ESOL Study Skills, and/or additional academic classes or electives.

If you have met all of the core requirements you may choose other options for your IB classes.
