	ERIA FOR ACCEPTING OUT-OF-DISTRICT TUTTION STUDENTS
1.	The student must provide Hall County Schools a complete packet of the following documents: Official transcript (report card and standardized test scores) from current school Official and complete discipline records from student's current and former school(s) – if the student has no history of discipline, then please submit a letter from the school stating
	that the student is in good standing. Official attendance records from student's current/former school(s)
	If a student is entering kindergarten, please include a letter of recommendation from a
	current preschool teacher or any other preschool records.
2.	For an application to be considered, student transcript should show, at a minimum, satisfactory behavior and attendance, and average/above-average grades with no history of failing courses. The Out-of-District Committee acceptance decision is final.
3.	No student will be admitted or continue enrollment who has had out-of-school suspensions, tribunals, arrests, or a criminal record.
4.	In order for a student to continue enrollment, the program services already in place at the school in which student is enrolled must be sufficient to meet a student's educational needs. Hall County Schools must be able to accommodate the applicant without placing undue financial burden on the school system or overcrowding classrooms.
5.	Hall County Schools does not provide transportation for tuition students. Parents or guardians are responsible for the student's transportation to and from school.
6.	The prompt payment of tuition is a condition of enrollment.
7. 8.	Approval for one child to enroll out-of-district is not applicable to other children in the same family. In order for out-of-district enrollment to continue, parents are expected to maintain a collegial relationship with school staff and to support school policies and procedures.
9. 10.	Enrollment as an out-of-district student is a privilege that may be revoked and the student dismissed or expelled in accordance with Hall County Schools' policies or if the above criteria are not maintained. The Superintendent has the right to refuse admittance or revoke enrollment of any applicant.
11.	When moving to another school in the district, students will be evaluated with the above criteria for continued enrollment. If approval for enrollment is granted, students may have to attend a different school than requested based on available space. Principals will have final approval about school transfers.

Parents will be notified of acceptance decisions by June 23, 2018. If accepted, parents will receive a contract to complete and mail, along with tuition payment, on July 1 - July 16, 2018.

Hall County Schools Tuition for Out-of-District Students

(For students entering Hall County Schools as an out-of-district student in 2014 or later)

- \$1000 payment between July 1 and July 16 per enrollment year OR
- \$1200 per enrollment year in 2 installments (\$600 due July 1 July 16, 2018; \$600 due by November 1, 2018)

Additional High School Fees – to be paid at the time of exam registrations

- All out-of-district students must pay an additional \$300 or the actual cost of registration and fees (whichever is lowest) for AP exams taken in high school. Payment of AP exams is due in March of the exam year.
- International Baccalaureate students pay an additional \$600 or the actual cost of registration and exams (whichever is lowest) by October 1 of their senior year (or by October 1 their junior year if they are sitting for an IB exam) to offset the cost of IB exams.
