Instructions For Using The Fuel Master System

Diesel

- Write down odometer reading (mileage) before getting off the bus
- 2. Have ID# ready to enter when you get to Fuel Master (SS# without dashes)
- Remove nozzle and insert in tank, but wait to turn on handle to pump
- 4. Raise lid and insert ProKee. You should gently push in ProKee for 1 second.
- 5. You will be prompted to enter ID#. Enter ID# and then press "ENTER" key.
- 6. You will be prompted to enter odometer reading.

 Enter mileage and press "ENTER" key.
- 7. Fuel Master may say that your odometer reading is too low. If so, you should re-enter the odometer reading. If you get the same message, you must enter a higher number.
- number (*Usually 01 or 02*). Enter the pump pump number and press the "ENTER" key.
- have 30 seconds to begin fueling.
- 10. If you do not begin fueling within 30 seconds, you must start the process again.

Propane

- Write down odometer reading (mileage) before getting off the bus
- Have ID# ready to enter when you get to Fuel Master (SS# without dashes)
- Remove nozzle and screw into tank receiver (tight, but don't overtighten)
- Push in ProKee for 1 second.
- 5. You will be prompted to enter ID#. Enter ID# and then press "ENTER" key.
- 5. You will be prompted to enter odometer reading.
 Enter mileage and press "ENTER" key.
- The display should read the operator number and turn pump on
- 8. If you do not begin fueling within 30 seconds, you must start the process again.
