What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual Enrollment is a unique program that allows high school sophomores, juniors, or seniors to earn college credit toward a postsecondary certificate, diploma, or degree while simultaneously earning credit toward their high school diploma.



Why Dual Enrollment?

- •30 hours of Free Tuition/Books/Select Fees for eligible courses
- •Ability to participate in both high school <u>and</u> college events & activities (excluding sororities/fraternities and collegiate athletics)
- •Use of college facilities and services
- •One high school class = two high school periods
- •Eases the transition from high school to college by encouraging students to seek resources for assistance and develop collegiate-level study habits
- •Dual Enrollment General Education coursework transfers between all USG and TCSG institutions



Dual Enrollment Considerations

•Important Regulations:

- •Students lose funding eligibility after two course withdrawals
- •Dual Enrollment funding will not cover course re-takes
- •Main campus students must follow the college schedule/calendar and provide their own transportation to and from the college



Why Dual Enrollment at LCCA & IEC?

- •Transportation provided to/from home high school to/from IEC and LCCA


Eligibility Requirements Continued

STUDENTS MUST:

- ☐ Be at least 16 years old
- ☐ Be a high school junior or senior
- ☐ Have a minimum core/academic class GPA of 3.0 on their official high school transcript

APPLICATION Steps

- 1. Complete the Brenau DUAL ENROLLMENT APPLICATION FORM at brenau.edu/apply.
- 2. Submit official **High School transcript** to the Brenau Office of Admissions.
- 3. Complete the **Dual Enrollment Student Participation Agreement**.
- 4. Complete the **Dual Enrollment Registration Form.**







Admissions Criteria

COVID-19 2021 Dual Enrollment Admissions Changes

Due to canceled SAT/ACT dates, the University System of Georgia has made the decision to allow USG institutions to grant admission to Dual Enrollment students based on alternative admissions standards, including the use of the PSAT to determine admissibility.

Based on this new guidance, UNG has adopted the following admission requirements for Dual Enrollment students seeking admission for the 2021 semesters:

- GPA remains at 3.25 as calculated on completed RHSC.
- If SAT or ACT scores are available, utilize scores as usual to determine admissibility.

PSAT

If SAT or ACT scores are not available or applicant does not meet minimum test score requirements, students may use PSAT scores for admission. PSAT scores must come directly from the high school guidance counselor and can be sent to psat@ung.edu. PSAT test scores for admissibility:

PSAT Scores

- 490 EBRW
- 440 Math
- 960 Combined

Accuplacer

If no PSAT available or does not meet minimum scores, Accuplacer may be completed with following scores earned:

Accuplacer Scores

- 243 Reading
- 4 Writeplacer
- 266 Math

Students taking Accuplacer for consideration of admission for Dual Enrollment will be allowed to retest one time.

PreACT

PreACT scores can also be used for dual enrollment admission. These scores can be sent either directly from the ACT site or from the student's high school counselor.

PreACT Scores

- · 20 English or Reading
- 18 Math
- 20 Composite

- 3.25 RHSC GPA
- Minimum test scores





Benefits of Dual Enrollment

- ✓ Does not count against 127 HOPE or Zell Miller credit hours cap
- ✓ Tuition covered up to 15 hours per semester (for a maximum of 30 hours throughout the program)
- ✓ Get a jump start on college
- ✓ Immersed in college life, while still having opportunity to enjoy high school activities
- ✓ Courses apply to high school and college credit
- ✓ Online classes available

UNG Course Modalities

F - FULLY AT A DISTANCE

All or nearly all of the class sessions are delivered via technology. The course does not require students to travel to a classroom for instruction; however, it might require students to travel to a site to attend an orientation or to take exams.



H1 - HYBRID: 25-50% F2F

Technology is used to deliver 50-75 percent of class sessions. Segments of the class attend the classroom on a regular rotation based on classroom capacity with social distancing. Students will be notified by their professor of their attendance requirements prior to the first day of class.



F2F - FACE TO FACE

All of the class sessions are conducted in person in a classroom or lab. There may be online components of the class, but these are to supplement the in class instruction.


