What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual Enrollment is a unique program that allows high school sophomores, juniors, or seniors to earn college credit toward a postsecondary certificate, diploma, or degree while simultaneously earning credit toward their high school diploma.

Why Dual Enrollment?

- •30 hours of Free Tuition/Books/Select Fees for eligible courses (does not count toward HOPE hours)
- •Ability to participate in high school activities, use of college facilities and services and participate in college events(excluding playing NCAA sports)
- •Eases the transition from high school to college by encouraging students to seek resources for assistance and develop collegiate-level study habits
- •CORE Dual Enrollment General Education coursework transfers between all USG and TCSG institutions (all CORE on 5.0 scale)
- •One DE Class Per Semester = Two High School Periods & Year Long Credit

Dual Enrollment Considerations

•Important Regulations:

- •Students lose funding eligibility after two course withdrawals
- •Dual Enrollment funding will not cover course re-takes
- •Main campus students must follow the college schedule/calendar and provide their own transportation to and from the college



Nurse Aide (CNA)

They have a great deal of patient contact and perform essential tasks such as measuring vital signs, assisting with nutrition, and caring for patient's bathing, dressing, grooming and movement needs.






Medical Administrative Assistant Certificate

Medical administrative assistants are in high demand due to their ability to work in a variety of locations such as hospitals, clinics, and other ambulatory healthcare settings. Common job titles might include, unit secretary, medical office assistant, patient coordinator or admissions coordinator. Knowledge of medical terminology, anatomy, computer applications, along with excellent communication skills makes this a unique role in that it combines both direct and indirect patient care duties. It requires a strong balance of administrative skills and interpersonal abilities.

The certificate is a part of the Medical Assisting Diploma and Degree at Lanier Technical College.
