# Why Dual Enrollment?

- •Free books and tuition for almost all core and certificate classes
- •One college class = two high school periods
- One semester = yearlong credit
- •Ability to participate in high school classes & activities; use of college facilities, services and participate in college events (excluding playing NCAA sports)
- •Get a jump start on college and ease the transition from high school to college
- •CORE Dual Enrollment coursework transfers between all USG and TCSG institutions



•College classes are a semester long; 3hrs or more classes are credited as 1 full credit



# **Dual Enrollment Considerations**

#### •Important Regulations:

- •MAXIMUM of 30 hours of Free Tuition & Books (does not count toward HOPE hours)
- •Students lose funding eligibility after two course withdrawals
- •DE funding will not cover course re-takes
- •Selective Service registration requirement
- •Main campus students must follow the college schedule/calendar and provide their own transportation to and from the college



# Dual Enrollment – Academic Options with IEC

# 2 Year Cohort



#### **Program Components:**



- Cohort will consist of 2 DE blocks each (equivalent of four HS periods) beginning junior year of high school.

### **Benefits of Dual Enrollment**

Does not count against 127 HOPE/Zell Miller credit hours cap

Tuition covered up to 15 hours per semester (for a maximum of 30 hours throughout the program)

Get a jump start on college

Immersed in college life, while still having opportunity to enjoy high school activities

Courses apply to high school and college credit

Online classes available



#### **UNG Course Modalities**



#### F - FULLY AT A DISTANCE

All or nearly all of the class sessions are delivered via technology. The course does not require students to travel to a classroom for instruction; however, it might require students to travel to a site to attend an orientation or to take exams.



#### **F2F - FACE TO FACE**

All of the class sessions are conducted in person in a classroom or lab. There may be online components of the class, but these are to supplement the in class instruction.



#### H1 - HYBRID: 25-50% F2F

Technology is used to deliver 50-75 percent of class sessions. Segments of the class attend the classroom on a regular rotation based on classroom capacity with social distancing. Students will be notified by their professor of their attendance requirements prior to the first day of class.





# **Admissions Criteria**

#### A potential Dual Enrollment student must:

- Be entering their junior or senior year of high school at the time of enrollment. Cadets must be at least 17 years of age.
- Present a cumulative 3.25 RHSC GPA
- Meet the minimum test score requirements

# **Application Deadlines**

Submit application and all supporting documents by:

- Summer Semester: April 15<sup>th</sup> (mid-May to beginning of August)
- Fall Semester: May 15<sup>th</sup> (mid-August to mid-December)
- Spring Semester: November 1<sup>st</sup> (mid-January to beginning of May)
