Tadmore Elementary Communication Magnet is a school-wide program where students explore communication as a part of daily instruction in all content areas. We believe that students require a structured and supportive environment in which they are encouraged and challenged to listen for understanding, speak with clarity and engage in purposeful 'accountable talk" to explore a variety of topics.

Teachers support speaking and listening skills by providing students with core academic content and related vocabulary, asking open-ended questions, engaging students in conversational, procedural, and other specific types of talk, and providing opportunities for students to speak and listen to each other. Communication through written word, art, music, movement, and digital formats is a component of daily instruction.
