

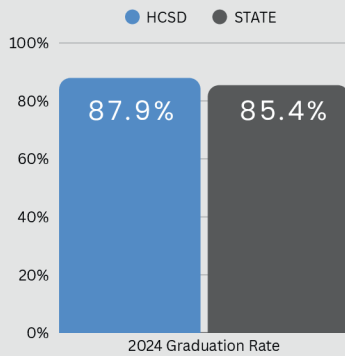

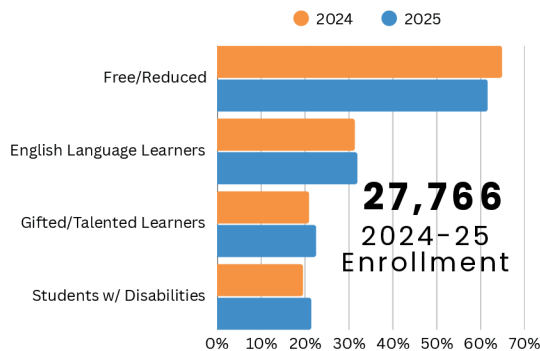

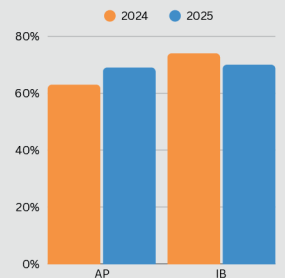

# STUDENT SERVICES

Over 90% of our K-12 students report having a trusted adult they can turn to when they have a question or problem. By grade level, the results are:

Elementary – **98.3%**, Middle – **93.5%**, and High– **91.8%**.

## SOURCES OF STRENGTH

was implemented in all middle schools and high schools.

**300+** peer leaders were trained.

SOS (Signs of Suicide) curriculum delivered to all students in grades 6-12.

## ACHIEVEMENT

In grades 3-12, overall math scores improved by at least 2%.

Notably, 8<sup>th</sup> grade closed the gap between the district and state math performance.

Third grade ELA showed strong gains, cutting the performance gap between the district and state in half.

Fifth grade ELA also demonstrated positive growth in reducing the gap between the district and the state by 3%.

The percentage of students reading at or above grade level increased in all elementary grades.

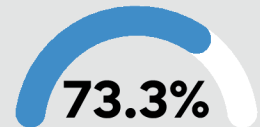

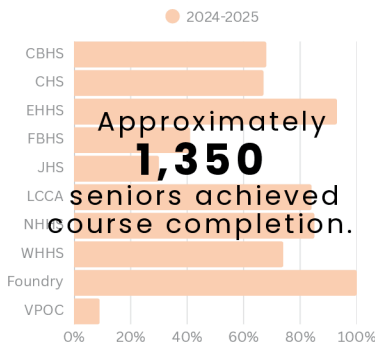
