The purpose of the VPOC is to build a connected community of teachers, staff, families, and students who will thrive in virtual learning. Accepted students will take all of their classes virtually. The virtual classes will have both synchronous and asynchronous components, and students can expect to have regularly scheduled live class sessions every week during the school day, as well as independent learning activities. 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NOTE: Out of District Transfers (not currently in the Hall County School System) must be approved by the Hall County District office prior to any Program of Choice offer of acceptance. District decisions take precedence, so POCs must hold any potential out of district applications until District decisions have been made. The Out of District Transfer Process for new students opens March 2nd. Once admitted to be an Out of District Transfer, the POC may send invitations to attend provided room is available. - **HB 251 transfer requests in the district open Monday, Nov 3 at 8:00 AM.**
- **Out of District (first time applicants) requests open March 2, 2026 with a Deadline of March 23, 2026 (Note: POC applications should still be submitted by the DEC 12th Deadline)**
