What Is Dual Enrollment?

A Tale of Two Programs

Core and 2000-level non-Core classes

*Weighted on a **5.0** scale (same as AP/IB)*

&

Certificate Courses

*Weighted on a **4.5** scale (same as high school Honors classes)*



Why Dual Enrollment Is a Win for Students & Families

Free Tuition & Books Up to 30 Credit Hours

Core and certificate classes cost nothing (excluding lab and some material fees), saving thousands on college.

Double the Credit, Half the Time

One college class counts for two high school periods, earning a full year of credit in just one semester.

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College Admittance Requirement



Brenau University

High school transcript must reflect a GPA of 3.0 or higher



Lanier Technical College

High school transcript must reflect a GPA of 2.6 or higher (CORE Classes)

High school transcript must reflect a GPA of 2.0 or higher (Certificate Classes)



University of North Georgia

Minimum unweighted core/academic class GPA of 3.25 on the official high school transcript. **(3.5 to take MATH 1111 without placement testing.)**

Transcript must be sent directly to UNG from STARS. The student must also have one of the following: **PSAT, PACT, UNG Accuplacer, SAT or ACT**

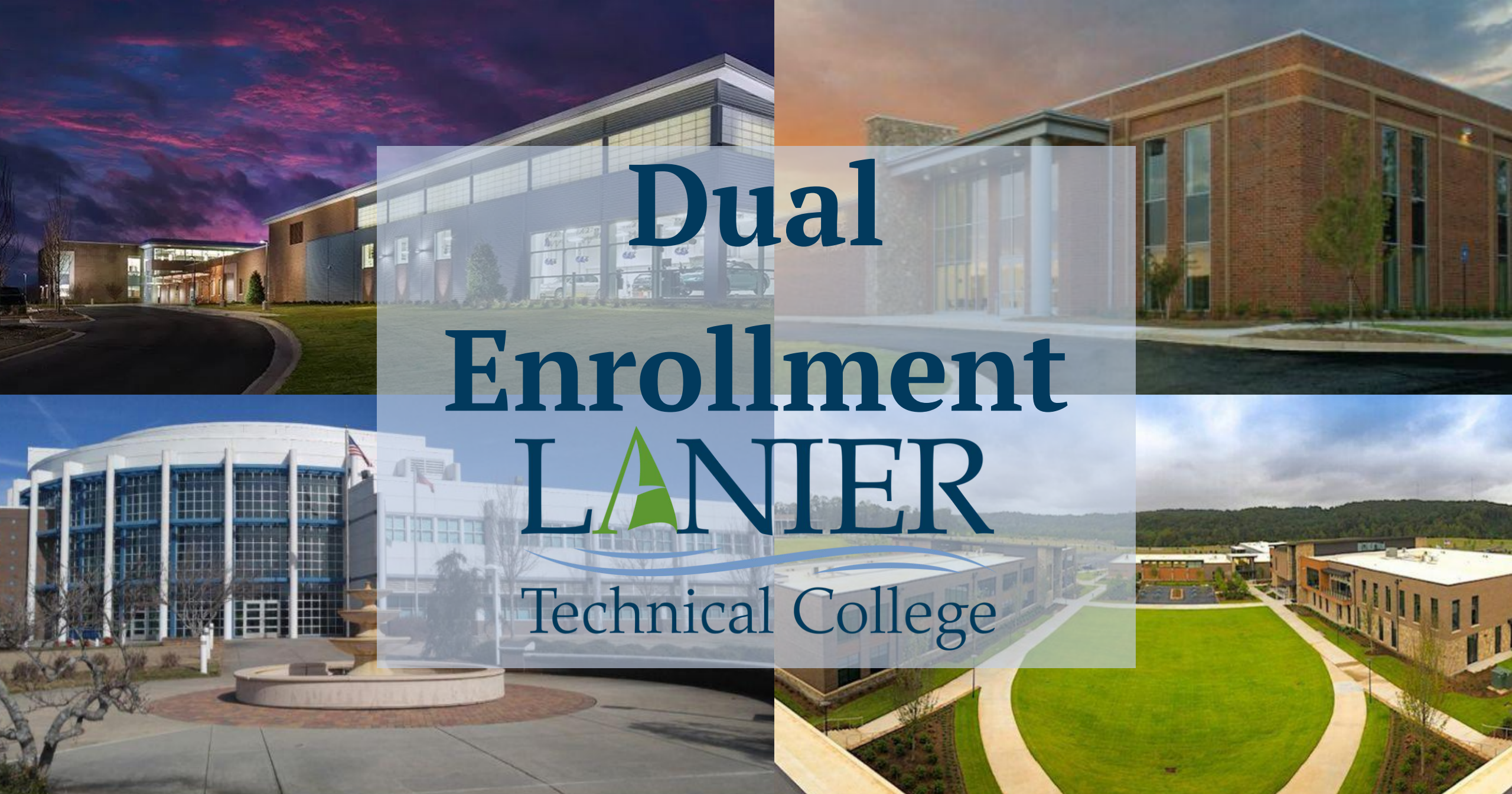


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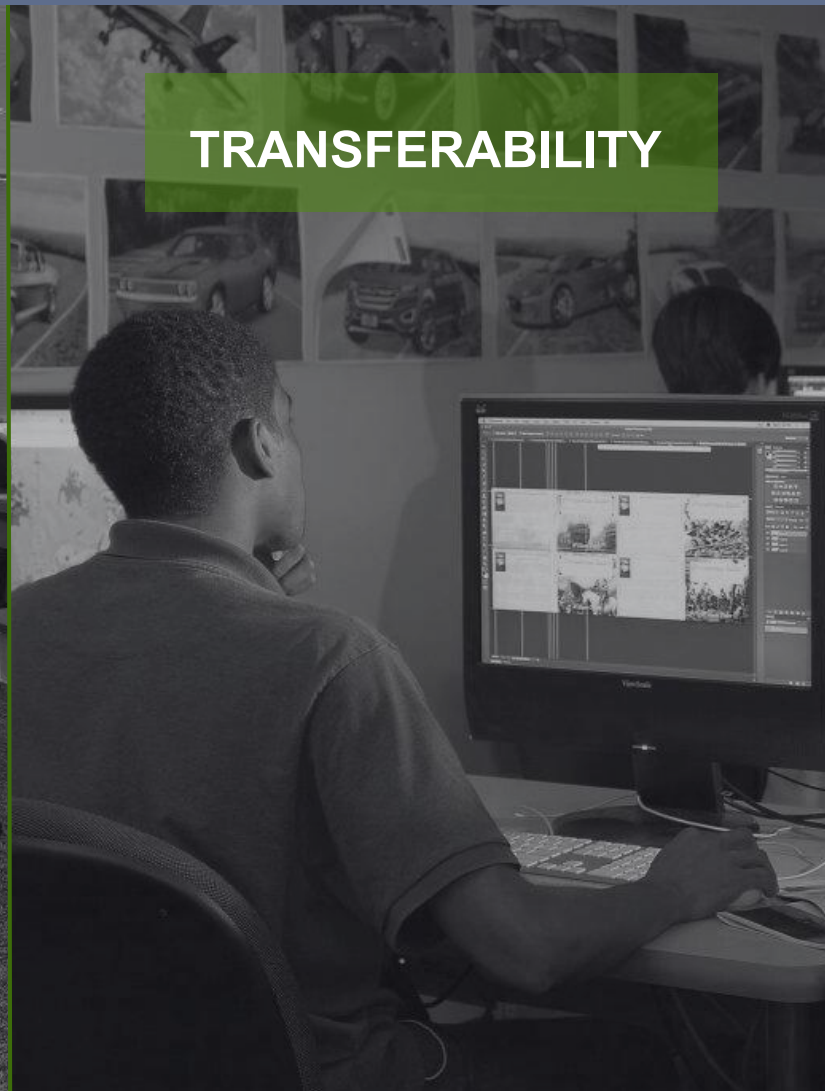

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS



- **Follow UNG student conduct guidelines.**
- **Maintain a 2.50 or higher college GPA and complete 67% of all attempted classes.**
 - *Letter grades earned at UNG figure into high school GPA.*
 - *Grades earned through DE could impact future eligibility for college admission, scholarships, and high school graduation.*
- **Check UNG student email regularly to stay informed on UNG Dual Enrollment dates, deadlines, and student expectations.**

TIPS FOR STUDENT SUCCESS



- **Develop time management strategies**
- **Communicate proactively**
- **Ask for help/Use college resources**
- **Prioritize collegiate work**
- **Turn in assignments on time**
- **Follow-up and follow through with instructions and recommendations**

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

SAT	530 Reading & Writing 480 Math
ACT	20 English or Reading 18 Math
PSAT	480 Reading & Writing 440 Math
Pre ACT	20 English or Reading 18 Math
Accu- placer	243 Reading, 4 Writeplacer 266 Math (QRAS)

- Student must be entering **junior or senior** year of high school.
- Student must present a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of **3.25 or higher** in their Required High School Curriculum (RHSC) coursework.
- The student must meet the subsection minimum requirements for a single test type.
 - **UNG accepts: SAT, ACT, PSAT, PreACT, Accuplacer**

APPLICATION PROCESS

1. Apply for admission through GA Futures

**The application fee is waived for all DE applicants.*

2. Request High School Transcript

**UNG Admissions must receive a copy of your transcript in a sealed envelope directly from the school or electronically through GA Futures.*

3. Submit official test scores

**Acceptable test formats: SAT, ACT, Accuplacer, pSAT, PreACT.*

4. Submit proof of lawful presence

5. Complete GAfutures funding application

**Separate application is required to obtain funding for DE courses.*

Fall: May 15

Spring: November 1

- ❖ *The Brenau Promise does not cover the cost of transportation, supplies, books, housing, meals or other university fees.*
- ❖ *To be eligible, a student must be a full-time, first-time freshman, **qualify for both the HOPE Scholarship and Federal Pell Grant** at any level as well, meet the Georgia residency requirement and sign a Brenau Promise Agreement.*

The Brenau Promise ensures that an eligible student's **full tuition and Institutional & Instructional (I&I) fee** are covered after all applicable institutional, state and federal scholarships and grants have been awarded. This means that a qualified student, who remains eligible, will **pay \$0 out of pocket** for their **tuition and I&I development fee** over the course of their undergraduate education at Brenau.



To be eligible you must:

- ✓ Be at least **16 years old**
- ✓ Be a high school junior or senior
- ✓ Have a **3.0+ GPA**
